Dear Robert Woock:

On April 7, 2020, the Department of Ecology received a Certification of Consistency with the Washington State Coastal Zone Management Program (CZMP) for the above project. On September 11, 2020, Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) and Ecology agreed to stay the CZM until April 6, 2021. On March 2, 2021, WSDOT and Ecology agreed to a second CZM stay until September 30, 2021. A third CZM stay was agreed to on September 17, 2021, extending the review period until November 30, 2021.

This decision is for improvements of the interstate, replacement of two bridges over the Sammamish River with three new bridges. The project also includes replacement of culverts, construction of stormwater facilities, and associated mitigation.

The project is located along a 5.27-mile section of Interstate 405 (I-405), between mileposts 21.79 and 27.06, in Bothell, Kirkland, and Woodinville, Washington, in King County and Snohomish County.

Pursuant to Section 307(c) (3) of the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 as amended, Ecology concurs with WSDOT's determination that the proposed work is consistent with Washington's CZMP.

YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL

You have a right to appeal this decision to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001 (2).

To appeal you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision:

- File your appeal and a copy of this decision with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this decision on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) E-mail is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
